## **BAND & ENSEMBLE**

This performance includes the core Jaimee Paul Band (vocals, trumpet, piano, bass, drums, guitar) plus additional musicians: a string quintet (3 violins, viola, cello), harp, and a woodwind/french horn section. The focus of the show is on lead vocals and trumpet, with piano and guitar as secondary features.

## **MONITOR REQUIREMENTS**

- 10 discrete mixes, wedges preferred
- Each performer receives their own mix (winds and strings may share)
- 12" wedges strongly preferred; 10" acceptable for vocals
- Separate EQ for wedges if possible
- No compression or gating to monitors; light reverb only if requested

## **BACKLINE & STAGE NEEDS**

- Concert grand piano (7' or larger), tuned to A440 day of show
- Rugs/carpets for drums and bass
- 10 music stands with lights
- Risers for strings and drums (harp on riser if available)
- Adequate mic stands (boom stands for most, straight stand for lead vocal and trumpet)
- Drum set if possible (rental to be provided by presenter/venue):
- Pro model Ludwig kits and Zildjian K Custom Dark cymbals preferred
- Acceptable alternates: Yamaha, DW, Gretsch (kits); Sabian or Paiste (cymbals)
- Drums: Ludwig Maple kit (20" bass drum, 12" tom tom, 14" floor tom, 5"x14" snare)
- Drummer will bring cymbals
- A few extra straight microphone stands for iPad/tablet holders

## **STAGE SAFETY**

- Clear, cable-free pathways from backstage to performance areas
- All cables dressed neatly and secured after soundcheck
- Cases and unused gear stored offstage
- Rugs to prevent slipping for rhythm section

## FRONT OF HOUSE (FOH) REQUIREMENTS

- Professional quality stereo PA system, capable of 100 dB sustained
- Flown line array preferred
- High quality reverb units (Lexicon PCM-91, TC M3000, Yamaha SPX, or equivalent)
- No compression unless absolutely necessary; soft knee, high threshold, low ratio

## LIGHTING

Lighting should provide tasteful ambiance and support mood shifts, not concert-style effects. Warm front light on all performers is essential. Color washes may vary between songs, but dramatic lighting changes during performance are discouraged. Haze acceptable. Spotlights only as appropriate and tasteful.

## PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS

- A competent, experienced sound engineer is required to run Front of House (FOH) and coordinate with the artists during soundcheck and performance.
- Adequate stage crew should be available for setup, cabling, monitor placement, riser moves, and general stage management before and during the show.










# A Night At The Cinema Stage Plot
