

Jaimee Paul & Leif Shires – Artist Biography

In a time when the world longs for peace and restoration, Jaimee Paul and Leif Shires have embraced a shared calling: to deliver hope and tranquility through the transformative power of music.

Jaimee Paul, a native of Southern Illinois, was raised on gospel and blues, her foundation rooted in the church choir. With a growing passion for jazz, she moved to Nashville to study Music Business at Belmont University. After graduation, she quickly made her mark in the industry through marketing and radio promotion roles at several record labels, while simultaneously building a career as a session vocalist. Her voice led her to international stages, singing background for artists such as Wynonna, The Judds, and Kelly Clarkson.

In 2008, Jaimee became the first female vocalist signed to Green Hill Music. Her debut album *At Last* reached #1 on the iTunes Jazz chart, followed by several acclaimed releases, including *Bonded*—a tribute to the James Bond film legacy produced by Grammy-winner Michael Omartian—and *Hear My Prayer*, a Dove Award-nominated hymns collection. Her 2023 release, *People*, featuring Pat Coil, Danny Gottlieb, Jacob Jezioro, and the Star City Symphony, received national attention on SiriusXM's *Siriusly Sinatra* channel. Most recently, in April 2025, Jaimee released *The Gershwin Songbook*—a lush and elegant reimagining of George and Ira Gershwin's classics, further solidifying her place among the finest vocal interpreters of the American songbook.

Leif Shires, a California native from the San Joaquin Valley, moved to Nashville in 2004, where he met Jaimee—a chance musical connection that quickly evolved into a creative and personal partnership in both marriage and music. A sought-after trumpeter known for his expressive tone and stylistic versatility, Leif has toured and recorded with a wide array of artists including Zach Williams, Kelly Clarkson, Jack White, Wanda Jackson, Barry Gibb, Jaci Velasquez, Eliza and the Bear, My Morning Jacket, and the legendary Memphis Horns, and countless others. In 2008, he became the first solo trumpet artist signed to Green Hill Music, and his most recent solo album, *Beautiful Love* (2023), has been featured on SiriusXM's *Escape* channel.

Together, Jaimee and Leif have performed across the U.S., Canada, Europe, and Japan, appearing before audiences that include a U.S. President, Prime Ministers, Members of Congress, and international ambassadors. Their collaborative work as the Jaimee Paul Band blends jazz sophistication with pop accessibility, as heard on their independent release *My Favorite Things*.

Marked by authenticity, warmth, and world-class musicianship, Jaimee and Leif's music continues to inspire audiences around the globe—through timeless songs, heartfelt performances, and a visible love for each other and the music they're honored to create.
